



WHO DO WE BELIEVE IN? BIBLE STUDY #6

In this lesson we would like to look into the Gospel of John to get a clearer picture of Jesus. That way we can believe in Him and rely upon Him better. Your faith in Jesus will grow as you see what the Bible says about Him.

1. At the end of the Gospel, John says that he wrote these things so that we can believe in Jesus. What result will this bring to us? (John 20:31)

In the first chapter of John verse 1, he refers to Jesus as "the Word" (a personal title use for Jesus Christ). We know that this refers to Jesus because it says in verse 14, "...the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth."
